

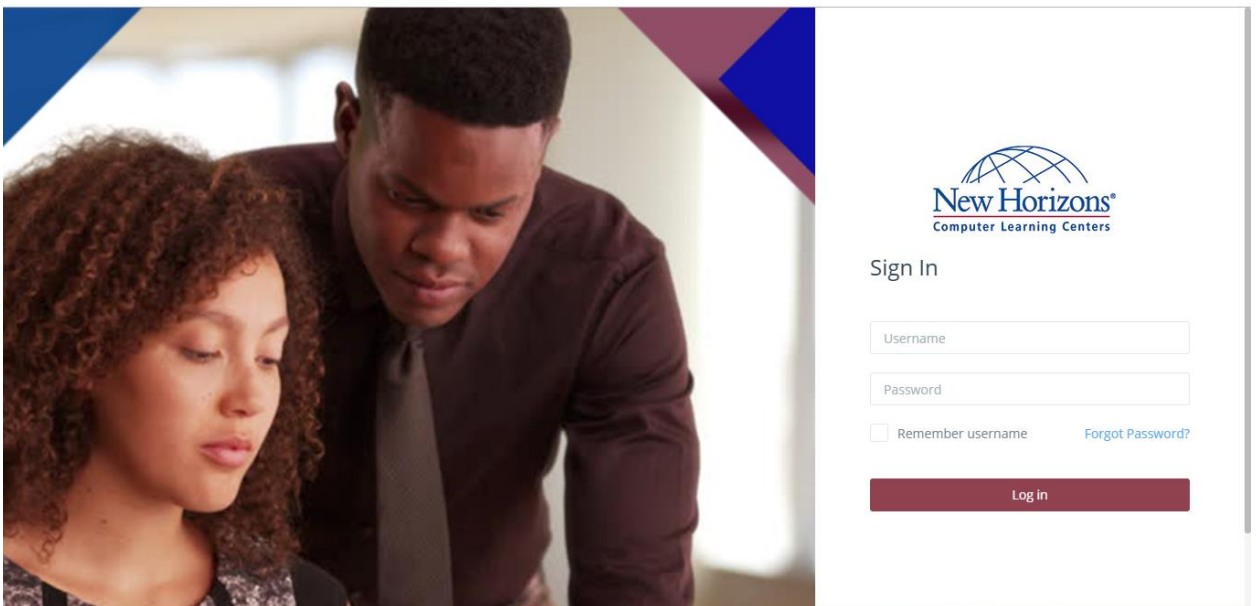

WHEN YOU ARE BOARDED, YOU WILL RECEIVE A MAIL WITH YOUR USERNAME AND PASSWORD.

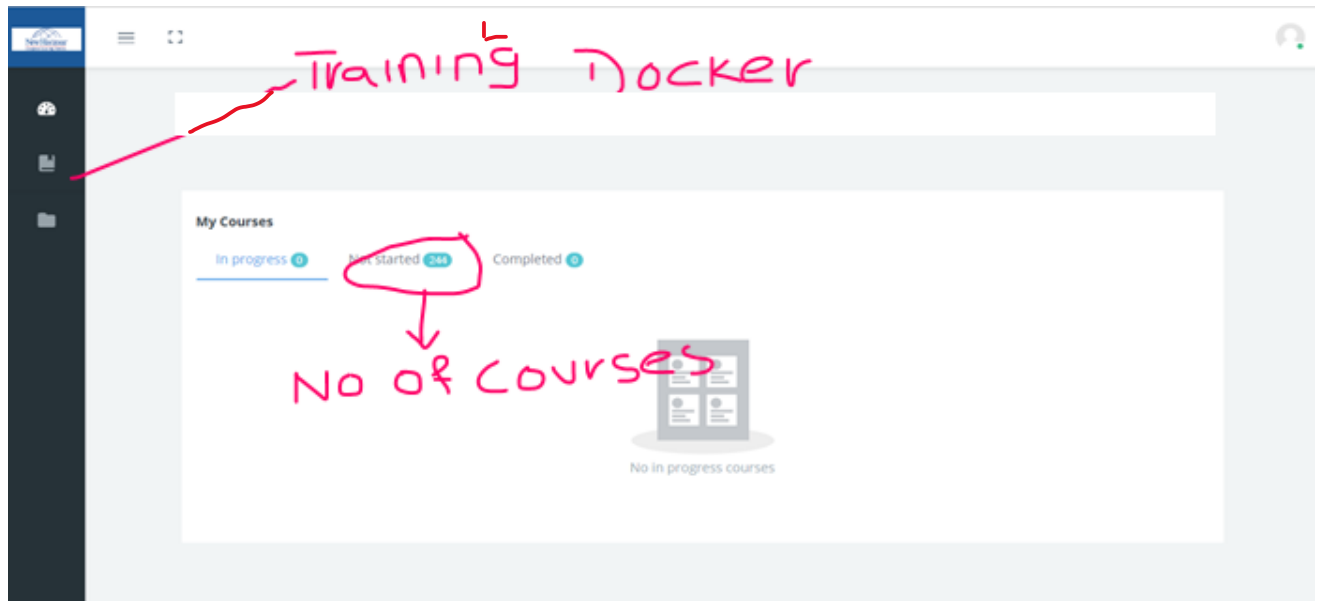
THEN:

1. FOLLOW THE LINK BY CLICKING ON IT. (YOU WILL SEE THE PAGE AS BELOW)

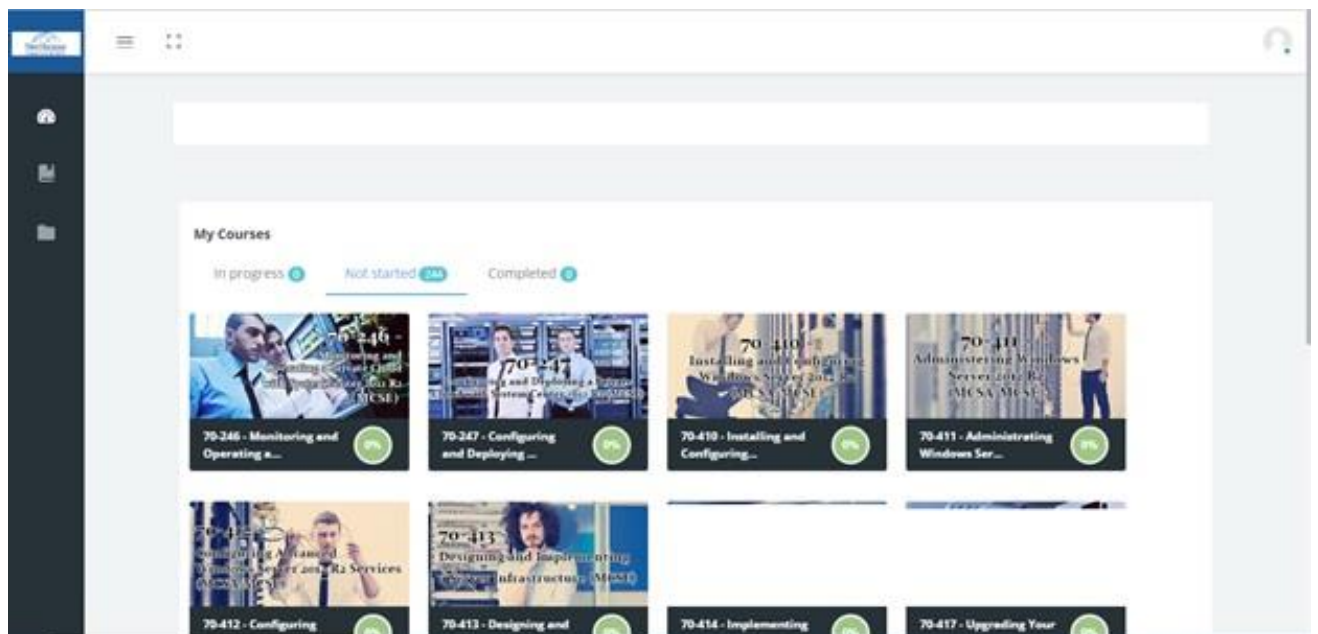


2. ENTER YOUR EMAIL (WHICH IS YOUR USER NAME).

7. CLICK ON "NOT STARTED"

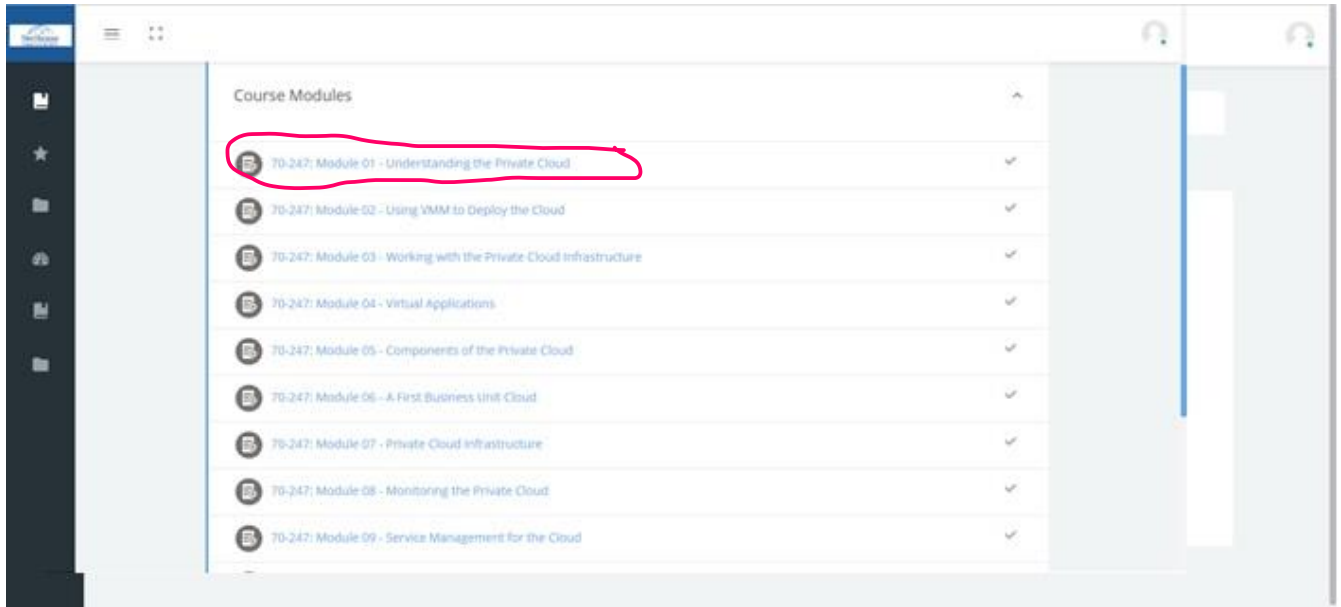
When you have logged in as a member, a new section of the site menu will appear.



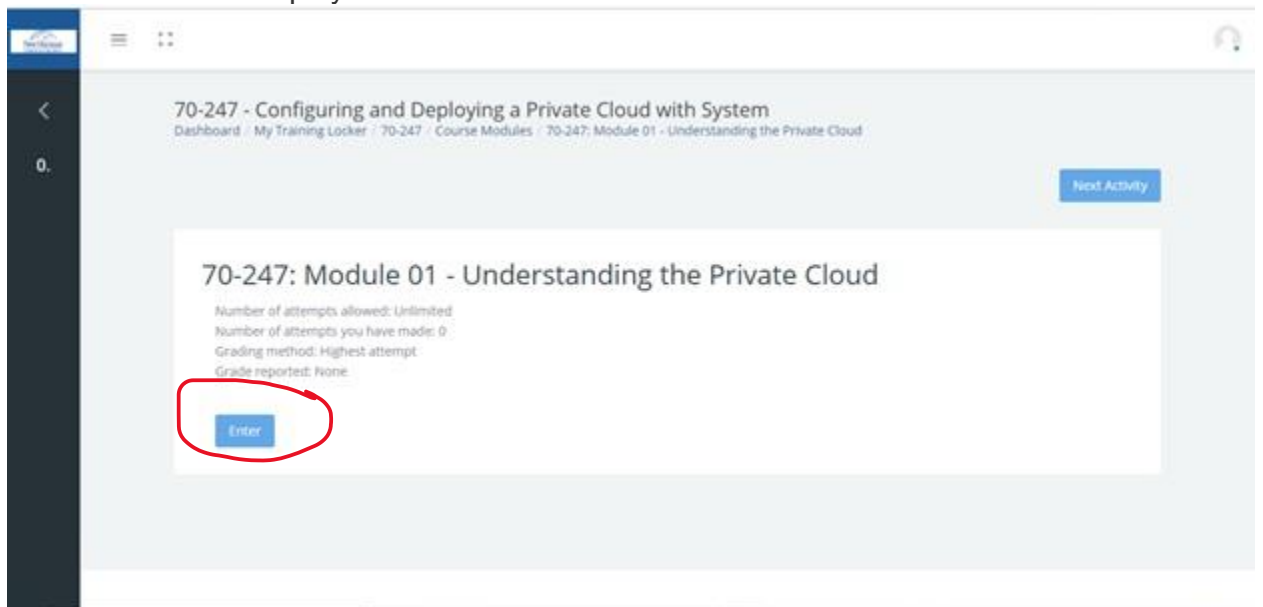




